

CODE OF CONDUCT

Rule 1: Listen to the crew

Always listen to what the Blaster Bash crew tells you to do. They are there to make sure that you stay safe and have fun.

Rule 2: Don't look threatening

Don't aim your blaster at police officers, park rangers, or security guards. If one approaches you, lay your blaster down on the ground and do what the officer tells you to do.

Rule 3: Don't hurt anyone

Don't hit, trip, push, pull, or throw things at anyone.

Rule 4: Don't damage anything

Don't damage the blaster, the barriers, or any other game equipment. Don't damage the play field, trees, bushes, flowers, buildings, or fences.

Rule 5: Don't cover the blaster dome

Don't cover the blaster dome with your hand, arm, hat, shirt, or anything else. To avoid being tagged, use your shields or hide behind a barrier or other obstacle.

Rule 6: Stay in bounds

Don't leave the game area during the game. If you are tagged out or disqualified, hold your blaster above your head and return to the starting area.

Rule 7: Be a good sport

Practice good sportsmanship. Remember that this is just a game. Everyone is here to have fun. Play fairly and don't be a bad winner or a sore loser. If you are playing on a team, cooperate with your teammates. Try to help your team win—don't be selfish.
